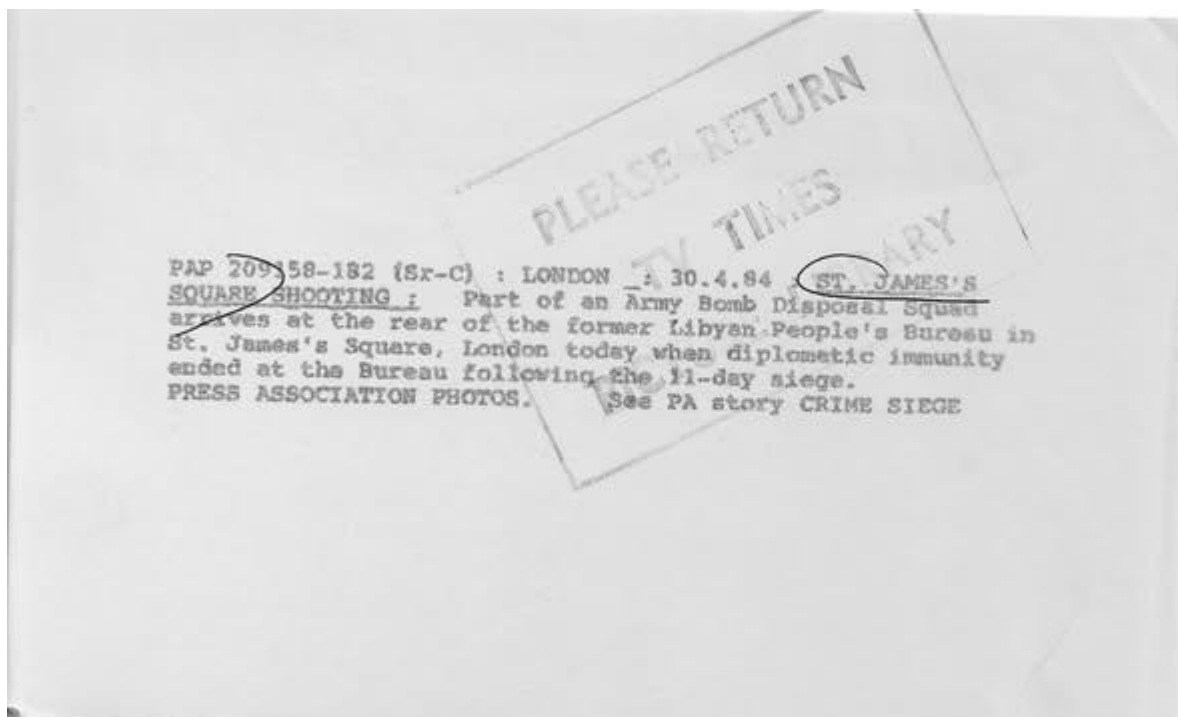


This Incident was at the Libyan Embassy 1984

RIP..screaming down the head set ...get out now! Intelligence corp had picked up movement in building ...

We exited sharpish and next thing we witness is WO2 Pascoe from our Search wing walking out of Lipyan peoples bureau side door in works dress, with a painting of Colonel Ghaddafi. You could not make it up...the end of a high profile operation and the start of 58 (EOD) Sqn RE search teams with 1 & 2 troops...
